THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIMERICK BY-LAW NO. 2012-08

Being a By-Law to appoint a Pro-Tem Chief Building Official
And a Pro-Tem Bylaw Enforcement Officer
For the Township of Limerick

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S. O. 2001, c.25, Section 5 (3) states that a Municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under section 9, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise.

AND WHEREAS The Police Services Act, R. S.O. 1990, c.P.15, Part 1, Section 15 (1) empowers a Municipal Council to appoint persons to enforce the bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Building Code Act, S.O. 1992, Chapter 23, Section 3 (2), states the Council of each municipality shall appoint a Chief Building Official and such inspectors as are necessary for the enforcement of this Act, in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Limerick enacts as follows:

- 1) THAT DALE SHANNICK be hereby Appointed Pro Tem as Chief Building Official for The Township of Limerick on a temporary basis at the pleasure of Council.
- 2) THAT BILL HAGGERTY be hereby Appointed Pro Tem as By-Law Enforcement Officer for The Township of Limerick on a temporary basis at the pleasure of Council.
- THAT such persons in their role as a By-Law Enforcement Officer and Chief Building Official shall be responsible for ensuring that the Bylaws of the Municipality are enforced and for carrying into effect the provisions of Municipal Bylaws, The Building Code Act and any Regulations thereunder;
- 4) THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passage by the Council of the Township of Faraday;
- 5) THAT this By-Law repeals all previous By-Laws and/or Motions of Council pertaining to the same.
