Roads Issues:

NOTE: THAT the Committee discussed and accepts the minutes from the previous meeting as presented.

NOTE: THAT the Committee discussed some concerns that have arisen about performance issues on Steenburg Lake North road. The Public Works and Infrastructure Manager has reviewed the area with the Municipal Engineer and the areas have been documented and will be reviewed again once the frost is out of the ground.

NOTE: THAT the Public Works and Infrastructure Manager provided an update on the O.C.I.F. project on St. Ola road.

THAT the current stakes that are installed along the roadway are control point stakes and that they do not necessarily represent property limits.

THAT the Municipality will be hiring an OLS company to identify the property limits of the project.

NOTE: THAT the Public Works and Infrastructure Manager provided a maintenance report to council.

THAT the Public Works Department requests patience with sweeping operations and that we must wait for winter operations to be completed prior to commencing sweeping on our hard-top roadways.

THAT the Public Works Department requests patience as we try to complete sweeping operations, grading and hard top patching as all these things are important operations and cannot be accomplished at once.

NOTE: THAT they discussed the proposed gravelling program for the 2018 season.

THAT the gravelling program will begin as soon as reasonably possible on the below listed roadways in the order they appear. We will work through the list until the 2018 gravel budget has been exhausted.

1. Old Hastings
2. Steenburg Lake South
3. Limerick Lake Lodge
4. Sutton
5. Robinson Lake
6. Tripp's

NOTE: THAT the Committee discussed the Carillion Lease Agreement and the salt storage facility.

THAT the Public Works and Infrastructure Manager is working with the local MTO representative to create a lease agreement for the facility.

NOTE: THAT the Public Works and Infrastructure Manager provided an updated roads section list with section lengths as information for the Committee.
