Mission Statement

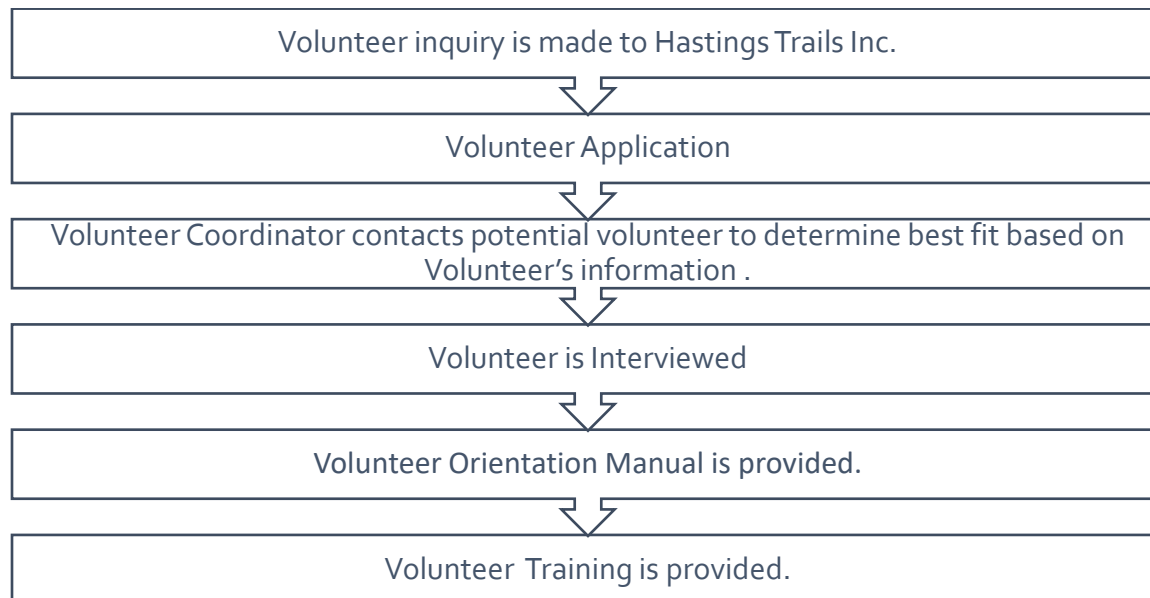
To promote the management, use, conservation and development of trails and trail-based tourism activities to improve quality of life and stimulate economic growth.

Volunteer Positions

Volunteer Coordinator

- Volunteer coordinator will act as liaison and oversees all volunteer activity for Hastings Trails.

Program/Events Coordinator

- Event coordinator will oversee every aspect of an event, from the conceptual planning of the event to who is going to clean after the event is over

Special Events Team Member

- Volunteers to help coordinate and facilitate Hastings Trails special events.

Trails Coordinator

- Trail Coordinator works with volunteer groups and oversees all aspects of trail maintenance and development.

Trail Captain

- Maintain the trails in a designated section.

Trail Maintenance Crew Member

- Helps with construction and repairs on the trails.

Marketing and Promotion Associate

- Helps with social media, marketing and promotional strategies.

Hike Leader

- Lead hikes, set the routes, set the pace and point out areas of interest.
